## A Note from the Principal

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Happy Thursday! We started the week with a blast of snow on Monday morning, and a late start Tuesday morning. The kids loved seeing the snow coming down, hoping and dreaming of building snowmen on the playground. It cleared out fairly quickly, but it was fun to watch the big snowflakes come down. This is a good reminder to check the weather each night, or the morning of school, to make sure your kids dress appropriately for school. We have several items in our lost and found stock as well. If your child is missing a coat, please have them check our lost and found.

The following was included in our newsletter last week, but I'm including it again, along with an attached flyer about the ballot measure.

Dieringer School District will have a proposition on the February 11 ballot (see the attached flyer). It is the Educational Programs and Operations Levy Renewal. This is a renewal of an existing levy, not a new tax. The levy pays for expenses that are not fully funded by the state, such as the non-high payment (to pay for Dieringer students who attend high schools in neighboring districts, because Dieringer does not have a high school), athletics, clubs, extracurricular activities, access to arts and music at all schools, salaries for teachers, librarians, nurses and counselors, special education programs, instructional materials and resources. It also helps pay for the upkeep of facilities, such as roofs, heating and mechanical systems and other infrastructure costs. More information will be sent home over the next 2-3 weeks. Please remember to vote on February 11.
